I continue to implement transformative solutions, such as an autonomy guide which was adopted as a Mayo Clinic best practice. I have maintained ACGME accreditation for the fellowship every year. I have successfully mentored one of the pediatric infectious diseases fellows as well as a pediatric resident in securing one of the highly contested oral presentations at a national infectious disease conference. I have mentored medical students, pediatric residents, and subspecialty fellows in 12 oral/poster presentations at national conferences and 15 publications. As the Vice Chair for Education for Pediatric Infectious Diseases, I direct the medical education of pediatric infectious diseases fellows, as well as pediatric residents and medical students on the rotation. I enjoy teaching trainees on the infectious diseases service, and have given many lectures. In the faculty development realm, we implemented a novel "faculty development learning plan", which was recognized as a best practice in the ACGME site visit.

As the Associate Program Director of Curriculum of Mayo Clinic's Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine Residency, I oversee the clinical and medical knowledge content of the curriculum. I serve as the Course Director for the Pediatric Acute Care Simulation and the Rotation Director for the Practical Pediatrics elective, which I helped reimagine. Due to my engagement and leadership in both trainee programs, I was asked to join the institutional Graduate Education Committee.

I have been an invited speaker at multiple Mayo Clinic-run CME courses including Pediatric Days, Infectious Diseases Practice Updates, Mayo Clinic Faculty Development Empowering Biomedical Educators, as well as the American Academy of Pediatrics Section on Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery. I have had various recognitions for my education efforts, including the 2022 Outstanding Contributions to Pediatric Education award and awarded the Senior Fellow level in the Mayo Clinic Academy of Education Excellence.

At a national level, I serve as the Chair of the Pediatric Infectious Diseases Society Education Committee, as well as serve on the American Board of Pediatrics practice analysis taskforce to inform the Pediatric Infectious Diseases Content Outline.

My passions in medical education include curriculum, evaluation, and creative educational approaches, such as gamification. I have created a virtual escape room at the national level, as well as was a founding member of the taskforce who produced the first ever in person escape room at IDWeek, the premier infectious diseases conference.

Infections of patients with primary immunodeficiency and immunocompromised hosts

My clinical interests have broadened over time to include diagnosing and providing longitudinal care for primary immunodeficiency patients, as well as taking care of immunocompromised hosts. My academic work has reflected that. I have investigated and published on the infections these incredibly complex patients are at risk for and may acquire.

Infections affecting neonates and infants

Neonates and infants represent a distinct group particularly susceptible to infections, often presenting with symptoms that differ markedly from those seen in older children and adults. My collected publications in this field emphasize the unique challenges in diagnosing and treating infections in this age group. They highlight the necessity for specialized approaches and underscore the complexity of managing these cases, emphasizing the importance of tailored strategies, including infection control, to effectively address the specific needs of this vulnerable population.

Pharmacology and vaccination in pediatrics

My academic pursuits have evolved to focus on determining safe and effective antimicrobial dosages for children, a group traditionally underserved in terms of precise pharmacological dosing guidelines. The advent of the COVID-19 pandemic has further complicated this landscape, introducing new variables in the form of vaccinations and monoclonal antibody treatments, whose effects and dosages in children are not fully understood. This area of study underscores the critical need for pediatric-specific research and data, which is essential for ensuring safe and effective treatment protocols for our youngest and often most vulnerable patients.
